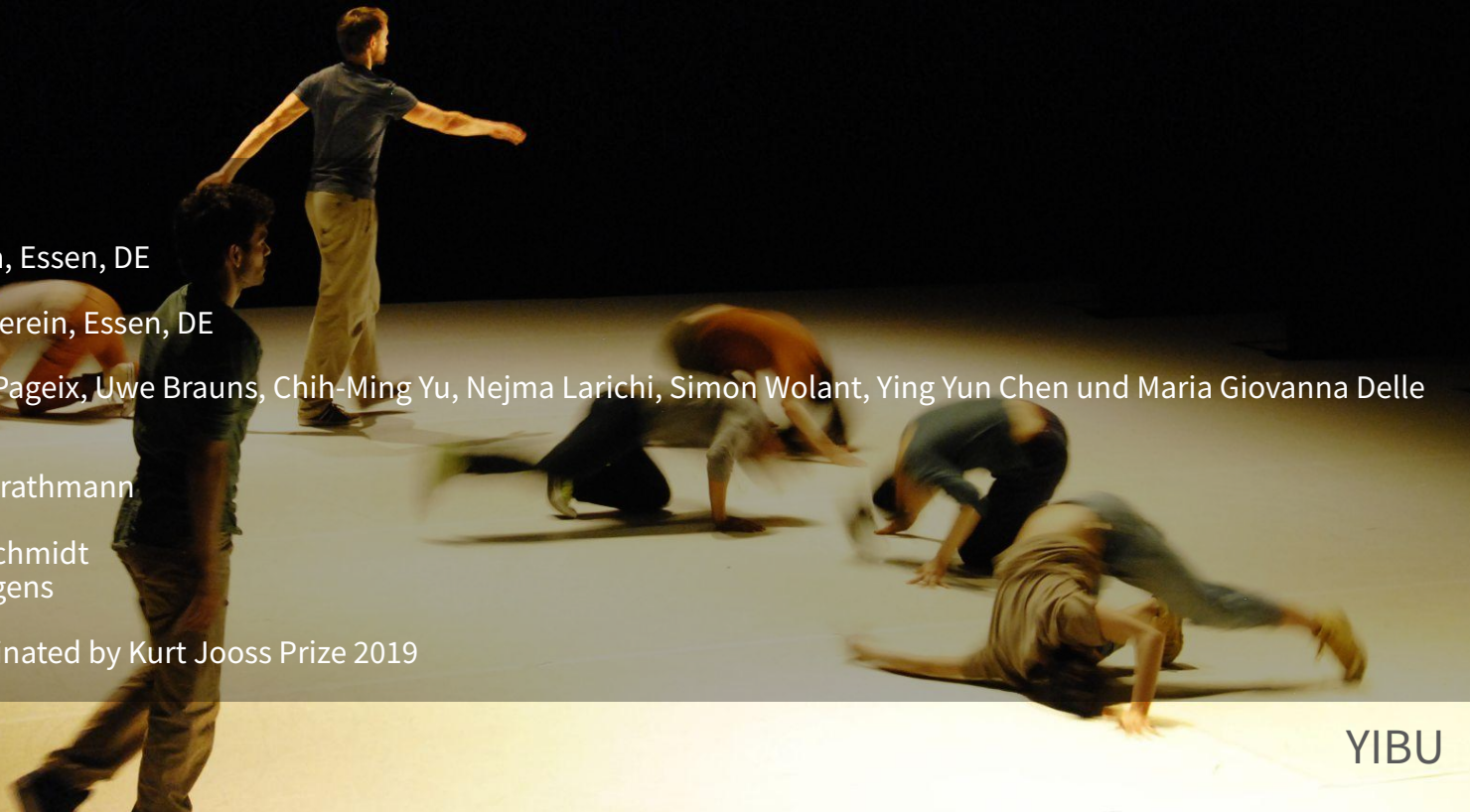

Paradox as the research theme found its shape and characters on the bodies of the dancers: obsessive, polarity quality in one body and shifting between two poles. Chun Zhang used her own developed technique “Grammatical Composition” in this piece, the narrative and emotional movements are all chopped under repetition, organization of space and time, into a minimal and neat style: our obsession living with the order given by the world, is the beauty of paradox and the paradox of beauty.
